Dear Counselor:

It's that time of year again! The Kansas Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (KACRAO) is offering the Glenn Lygrisse/KACRAO Scholarship. This scholarship is to reward and encourage students who have demonstrated quality leadership during their high school years. There are four \$250 awards available for the 2011-2012 academic year. The scholarships will be designated as follows; one per school type: four-year public, four-year private, community college, and technical/vocational. These scholarships must be used at a KACRAO member institution (list of member institutions enclosed). The scholarship is not need-based and may be used in conjunction with other awards at the discretion of the Financial Aid office of the attending institution. Complete applications received by the deadline will be considered for this award. Once the scholarship recipients have accepted their awards, an announcement will be posted on the KACRAO website ([www.kacrao.org](http://www.kacrao.org)) and all students will receive a letter notifying them of the outcome.

To be eligible for consideration for these scholarships, students must:

- ◆ Be in their senior year at a Kansas high school
- ◆ Have a cumulative seventh semester GPA of 3.25 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- ◆ Have a minimum ACT composite score of 22 or an SAT-I combined score of 1020
- ◆ Submit a complete application (application form, essay, letters of reference and resume) postmarked by March 11, 2011
- ◆ Provide evidence of leadership experience

**Glenn Lygrisse/KACRAO Scholarship Application  
Deadline: March 11, 2011**

The Kansas Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (KACRAO) offers scholarships to reward students who have demonstrated quality leadership during their high school years. There are four \$250 awards available for the 2011-2012 academic year, which may be used at KACRAO member institutions (a list of institutions can be found on our website at [www.kacrao.org](http://www.kacrao.org)). The scholarships will be designated as follows; one per school type: four-year public, four-year private, community college, and technical/vocational. The awards are not need-based and may be used in conjunction with other awards.

To be eligible for consideration for these scholarships, students must:

- ✓ Be in their senior year at a Kansas high school;
- ✓ Have a cumulative seventh semester GPA of at least 3.25 on a 4.0 scale;
- ✓ Have a minimum ACT composite score of 22 or SAT-I combined score of 1020

To be considered for these scholarships, the student must submit:

- I. A complete application form including verification/signatures from a guidance counselor
- II. A one-page essay responding to one of the following statements:
  - a. Describe one of your biggest accomplishments that you feel demonstrates your leadership experience. Consider instances in which you have significantly influenced others, helped resolve disputes, or contributed to group efforts over time either in or out of school.
  - b. Describe the most significant challenge you have faced and the steps you have taken to address this challenge. Include whether you turned to anyone to help you face the challenge, the role that person played, and what you learned about yourself.
- III. A letter of reference from a school official (counselor, teacher, principal, club sponsor etc.)
- IV. A letter of reference from a community leader (business leader, employer, church leader, etc.)
- V. Resume detailing leadership experiences
