To apply or be awarded this scholarship does not in any way bind the individual to join the Delta Chi Fraternity. All applications must be received by April 15, and finalists will be notified by mail of their selection and given further details about the process. A scholarship reception will be held in Manhattan to announce the winner, and all finalists for the scholarship must attend the announcement. We will enclose details about the date and time of the reception with the finalist selection notification.

To qualify for this scholarship, an individual should have a 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale or equal ratio on a 5.0 scale) cumulative high school grade point average. Areas of consideration in determining the recipient will be scholarship, leadership, involvement, and service.

The following is a brief description of the scholarship:

The James Komatz/Delta Chi Memorial Scholarship was created to honor the memory of a former Kansas State student and undergraduate member of the Delta Chi Fraternity. Mr. Komatz passed away after a year-long battle with cancer. He was the ideal example of a member of the fraternity who demonstrated a strong level of commitment, enthusiasm and compassion for his fraternity brothers.
