

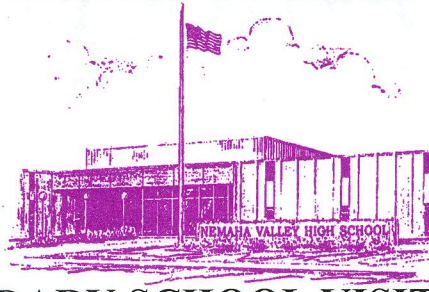

POST-SECONDARY SCHOOL VISITATION FORM

Seniors will be allowed to make two visitations to colleges, vocational and trade schools to explore post-high school educational opportunities. Students visiting a college or technical school must follow this procedure:

- ① Arrange a visitation date on your own time. Once arranged, tell the counselor the details of the visit and this form will be provided to you.
- ② Complete the middle section of this form (ALL PARTS, including parent signature).
- ③ Take the form to the NVHS office to obtain a pre-absence form, which must then be signed by your teachers at least one day before the school visit.
- ④ Have a representative from the office of admissions complete the lower portion of this form on the day of the visit.
- ⑤ Return the form to the NVHS counselor THE NEXT SCHOOL DAY (after your visit) for the final date and signature (bottom).
